Expresses profound disagreement with President's decision to restore full diplomatic relations with Cuba.

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION expressing profound disagreement with the decision of the President of the United States to restore full 2 3 diplomatic relations with Cuba. 4 5 WHEREAS, On December 17, 2014, the President of the United States announced that this country would restore full diplomatic relations 6 7 with the nation of Cuba after more than 50 years of unconcealed 8 hostility; and 9 WHEREAS, Cuba has been under the crushing yoke of a brutal 10 communist dictatorship since 1959, led first by Fidel Castro and 11 more recently by his brother Raul; and WHEREAS, The actions of the Castro brothers have resulted in the 12 impoverishment of the Cuban people, and the complete and blatant 13 14 disregard of human rights and democratic principles by the 15 government of that Caribbean nation; and 16 WHEREAS, Cuba under the Castros has been an active and ominous 17 threat to the vital interests of this nation and all peace-loving countries, as members of Cuba's military and diplomatic corps have 18 19 worked assiduously through the years to promote violent, anti-20 democratic revolutions in different parts of the world; and WHEREAS, The diplomatic initiative announced by the President 21 22 involved the release of U.S. government subcontractor Alan Gross by Cuba after five years of detention due to the absurd and 23 24 unfounded allegation of being a spy, and the release by the United 25 States of three convicted Cuban spies linked to terroristic activities 26 in this country; and WHEREAS, Numerous respected public federal and State officials, both 27 Democratic and Republican, have denounced this move by 28 29 President Obama and believe strongly that it will do nothing to free 30 the Cuban people from the poverty and injustice they have suffered for more than half a century and that it will only serve to support a 31 32 tottering and bankrupt dictatorship; and 33 WHEREAS, Residents of New Jersey are very familiar with the 34 viciousness of the Castro regime because the State has become the 35 home of thousands of Cuban-born men and women who fled from a regime intent on stealing their property and putting them at the 36 37 service of a brutal military government, and who know first-hand how the Castro brothers have destroyed the culture and economic 38 39 vitality of their homeland; and 40 WHEREAS, It is fitting and proper for this House to express profound 41 disagreement with the decision of the President of the United 42 States to restore full diplomatic relations with Cuba; now, 43 therefore, 44 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Senate of the State of New Jersey: 45 46 47 1.
